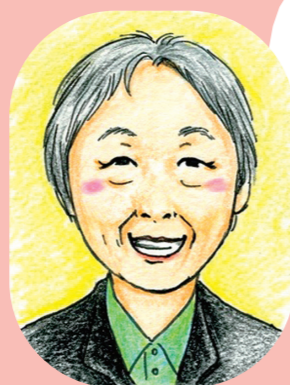
## Discover the Hills, Slow Walking Course

The Jigokuzaka or "hell slope" found on this course is also known as a "gourmet slope". When you feel tired walking up the hill, take a break at one of the popular cafes here. When hungry, there's well-known restaurant waiting. The superb view great food will bring pleasure to both body and soul.

When walking this course, you may encounter landscapes that resemble famous paintings of Zensaku Nakamura or Zen'yu Sato. Enjoy this beautiful scenery that many famous painters fell in love with, and try to find your favorite landscape.

There're a lot of hills in Otaru because it's surrounded by mountains and sea. Let's say you go up a steep slope road then look back, you'll see beautiful sceneries such as sailing ships in the blue ocean or hazed Mashike mountain range. Also at the bottom of hills, you can enjoy the historic buildings which were built when Otaru was prospered as a commercial city in Hokkaido.

### Hill Course Starting Point and Access Information

#### MAP ① Otaru station

The entrance faces National Route 5, with a bus terminal and a taxi stand right in front. There is a tourist information center inside the station building where you can get tourist guide maps and information.

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# Tourist Spot Information

**MAP ① JR Otaru Station**  
 Built in 1934 as the first RC construction in Hokkaido.

5-minute Walk

**MAP ② Funamizaka Slope**  
 Funamizaka Slope which has 15% grade is one of the most steepest slope roads in Otaru. It's known as a popular filming location.

20-minute Walk

**MAP ③ Otaru Catholic Church Tomioka Cathedral**  
 The church with a red spire on a sunny day looks like a fabulous painting.

20-minute Walk

**MAP ④ Otaru University of Commerce**  
 The only national university in Otaru and it's located on the top of Jigokuzaka slope. Famous novelist Sei Ito and Takiji Kobayashi learnt there.

35-minute Walk

**MAP ⑤ Otaru Civic Auditorium** Closed  
 (Closed from June 23 to the end of October 2024 for tile roof renovations)  
 Built in 1911 when the Japanese crown prince at the time visited to stay.

5-minute Walk

**MAP ⑥ Otaru Park**  
 Opened in 1893. It's a good place to enjoy cherry blossom and azalea in spring, wisteria trellis in the beginning of summer and red leaves in autumn.

20-minute Walk

**MAP ⑦ Suitengu Shrine**  
 It's located at the top of the hill and you can look over the Otaru harbor.

20-minute Walk

**MAP ⑧ JR Minami Otaru Station**  
 A station for Horonai Railway which was opened in 1880 as the first railway in Hokkaido. It was named Kaiuncho Station and changed to the current name Minami Otaru Station in 1920.



**Slope Information**

- Dangozaka Slope**  
 The slope was named Dangozaka slope (Dumpling slope) because it was a shorter way to a famous dango shop.
- Gaijinzaka Slope**  
 The slope was named Gaijinzaka slope (Foreigner slope) because a German family was living at somewhere close to the 123 stone steps between Suitengu shrine and Sakaimachi.
- Shokuninzaka Slope**  
 The slope was named Shokuninzaka slope (Craftsman slope) because there're many stores by craftsmen such as Buddhist altar builders, painters, metal artisans, woodwork joiners and frame builders.
- Sanbongizaka Slope**  
 The slope was named Sanbongizaka slope (Three trees slope) because there were 3 big Japanese elm trees in the middle of the slope. They are gone now but the sailors were using those huge trees as a landmark from the sea.
